RULE 8: The games must be started with the number of players present after 10 (ten) minutes of the appointed time during the summer League. ALL winter league games <u>must</u> start at the allocated time on the fixtures. Failure to play the game due to lack of players must result in the non-offending team claiming 5 (five) points from the offending team. Games can be played with a minimum of 5 (five) players per team.

Due to recent complaints received by the committee, we wanted to point out the rule around start times for games which differ from winter to summer leagues—there is no ley-way in the winter, all games must start on time with the required number of players. Failure to do so will result in the non-offending team claiming the points. Please ensure your teams are fully up to speed with the WCNL rules which you can find on our website - wcnl.co.uk
